Drain & Sewer Line Repairs

- Broken, cracked, offset or collapsed pipes

In addition to traditional repair and replacement methods for minor and major projects, we utilize the latest technology for trenchless sewer line replacement. We can diagnose and propose alternative solutions that address both your business operation and your budget concerns.

Traditional Repairs

Sewer line repairs are typically performed using the "open cut" or "trench" method to gain access to the area surrounding the damaged portion of the pipe. A backhoe may be used to open and refill the work area.

Trenchless Repairs

Trenchless sewer line repairs cause less damage than traditional sewer line repair techniques since only small access holes are usually necessary to complete the repair. Trenchless methods allow for minimal damage parking lots, sidewalks and landscaping.

- Pipe Bursting - Using your broken sewer pipe as a guide, our hydraulic pipe bursting machine pulls full-sized replacement pipe through the old path and breaks up the damaged pipe at the same time.
- Pipe Relining - Relining is the process of repairing damaged sewer pipes by creating a "pipe within a pipe" to restore 100% function and flow. Epoxy relining materials mold to the inside of the existing pipe to create a smooth and tough new inner wall.
